

Happy Anniversary to all of you!

Today on October 26th, 2014, we celebrate:

1819

195 years since the beginning of the Cornwall Pastoral Charge, which started as part of the Charlottetown Methodist circuit;*

1842

172 years since the use of a log cabin for church services;*

1856

158 years after the Cornwall and Little York churches separated from the Charlottetown circuit to form their own;*

1874

140 years since new circuits were created with Cornwall being the head of congregations at Cornwall, Princetown Road(Springvale), SouthWiltshire (Kingston), North Wiltshire and Highfield.;

1893

121 years since removal of Highfield and Princetown from the Cornwall Charge;*

1902

112 years since the New Methodist Church of Cornwall was officially opened in the location where our church stands today;*

1920s

discussion on Union of the Cornwall Methodist and Clyde River Presbyterian congregations;*

1926

88 years since the formation of the Cornwall Pastoral Charge, United Church of Canada, which included the congregations of Cornwall, Kingston, Hampshire, North Wiltshire and New Dominion;*

1960

54 years since major renovations to the church building (foundation, Sunday School classrooms, kitchen, furnace room, bathroom and auditorium);

1980-82

34 years since additional major renovations (large hall, second storey, large kitchen);

2012

2 years since the celebration of the 150th anniversary of the New Dominion congregation;

2013

1 year since the celebration of the 150th anniversary of the Kingston congregation;

2014

2 months since the amalgamation of the Cornwall, New Dominion and Kingston congregations.

2019

A time capsule sealed in 1994, will be opened on the 200th Anniversary of the beginnings of the Cornwall Pastoral Charge.
