Trustee Update

The Trustees have compiled an inventory of the contents of the two buildings and will be also taking a complete inventory of the former Cornwall United Church. It is important to note, according to the Manual (The United Church of Canada governance rule book), that all properties and contents are the property of the United Church of Canada and therefore now fall under the direction of the new Pastoral Charge. The contents that will be used in the Church will be identified, relocated and preserved. As you may see, some of this has taken place already. Those items for which we do not have a purpose may be offered to other charitable organizations (other Churches or Church camps for example). Some items may be offered for sale. As a registered Canadian Charity under the Income Tax Act, we are not permitted to return donated items to the donor. A donor could, if the item were being offered for sale, purchase the item for fair market value.

The Faith in Action Committee is pleased to announce that once again we will continue to participate in the **Food Hamper and Gift Program** as a shared project with St. Francis of Assisi and the Burnside Presbyterian Churches.

As with other years, the Cornwall Pastoral Charge has assumed responsibility for 10 families which includes about 40 adults and children in total.

We invite you to make monetary donations towards the purchase of the food hampers and the gift certificates. The cost of a food hamper is \$60 and a gift certificate is \$25. Please make monetary donations only as we will be doing bulk purchasing. Don't forget to include your envelope or PAR number on your donation envelope. Ideally, we'd like to receive all donations by December 15th but they will be gratefully received anytime. Also, this is the time of year when our Pastoral Charge's **Benevolent Fund** is usually the beneficiary of your generosity. The Benevolent Fund is used to support persons in need or in crisis throughout the year.

Living Nativity

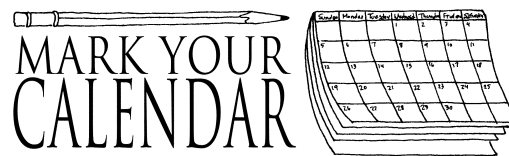
