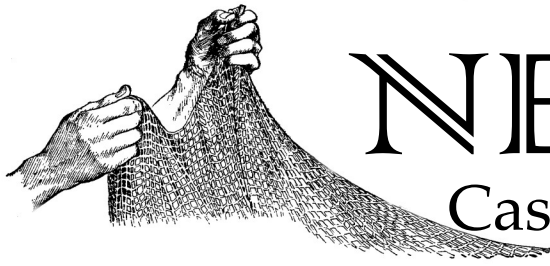

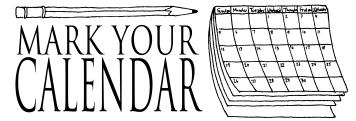
Sadie Off the Rails
