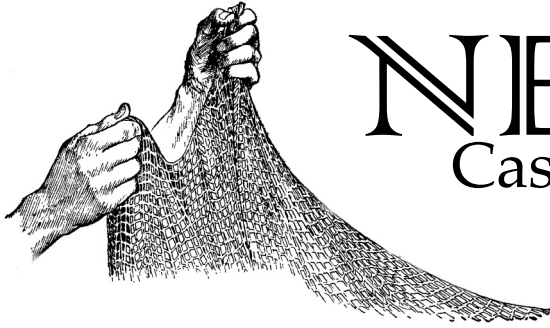

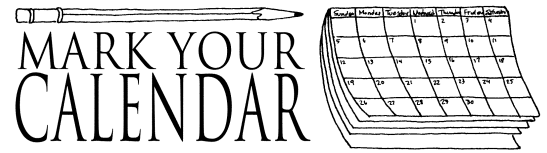
Tree Planting
